Homework will be set each Friday, and is due to be handed in by the following Friday please. Class spellings will be given out each Friday and tested on Thursday. 'Irresistible Isles'

Literacy

Literacy learning this term will be based around the book 'Wreck of the Zanzibar' by Michael Morpurgo, where the children will be writing a book review to compare 'Friend or Foe' - a book read from another unit previously in the year. We will also be writing our own non-fiction texts to persuade readers to visit the Isles of Scilly.

Maths

In Maths, Class 3 will be measuring, comparing and estimating different weights, looking at a range of scales. We will also be revisiting the four operations and apply them in different contexts, and revisit a range of different mathematical skills covered during the year.

Science

Our Science focus this half term is rocks. We will be identifying different types of rocks and looking at how rocks and fossil are formed.

Computing

We will be continuing to learn how to insert information into a table and graph.

E-safety

Children will learn what constitutes as personal information and the importance of keeping personal information secure.

Religious Education

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of 'God Talk' in the context of 'Christian and Jewish views'.

Physical Education

PE for Class 3 will take place on Mondays as usual with Aspire and Friday afternoons. On Friday afternoons children will continue taking part in their swimming lessons at Bedales.

Music

In music Class 3 will continue to identify the use and purpose of different layers in music heard, created and performed in the context of Samba.

PSE - Personal and Social Education

This half term we will be talking about 'Changes'; discussing the changes that happen in their lives and the feelings in relation to these changes.

French

In French we will be asking and answering questions by recognising words and phrases we have learnt over the year.

DT

Children will be designing and constructing a raft out of a range of materials using cutting and joining with accuracy.

Art

On our art days this half term we will be sketching and painting self-portraits.

Geography

Our topic this half term is all about the Isles of Scilly. We will be using maps, atlases and globes to locate the Isles of Scilly, find out how far it is located from us and make comparisons. We will also identify human and physical features of the Isles.
