Literacy

We will be focusing our lessons around the book *The Firework-Maker's Daughter*. We will write for a range of purposes, including character descriptions and diary entries.

Maths

Our first focus will be to deepen our understanding of place value and how to calculate in all four operations using numbers with an increasing number of digits. We will then be applying this to reasoning about numbers.

Science

In Science we will be deepening our understanding of electricity by comparing and giving reasons for variations in the function of components in an electrical circuit.

Computing and E-safety

We will be linking our computing with topic work by understanding more complex features of Microsoft Word.

Religious Education

Our first Concept day will consider the key question: 'Creation or Science; conflicting or complimentary?'

History

Our History learning this half term will focus on creating an overview timeline of where and when the first civilisations appeared around the World.

Physical Education

PE for Class 4 will be on Mondays and Fridays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays, while Friday's focus this half term will be swimming for Year 5s. Year 6s will be focusing on ball skills. PLEASE make sure every child has running shoes in school on every day of the week, as we will be adding extra slots for PE whenever we can.

RHE – Relationships and Health Education

We will be looking into personal attributes and qualities and deepening our understanding of individuality.

French

We will be learning how to tell the time in French, recapping the numbers to 80, months of the year and how to ask questions and give responses. Our French grammar focus will be on the use of the masculine/feminine for nouns.

DT

Our focus objective is to learn how to support structures through the building of bridges.

Music

We will be creating a rap using a common hook and verses through group work.
