Literacy

Literacy learning this term will be based around the text 'Friend or Foe', a longer text by Michael Morpurgo. Class 3 will be writing a range of different text types over the half term including: character descriptions, letters and diary entries.

Maths

In Maths, Class 3 will be learning about place value using two, three and four digit numbers, identifying each digit and ordering numbers. We will also develop our mental methods fluency in addition and subtraction using a range of different maths equipment.

Science

Our Science focus this half term is 'Sound'. We will be learning how sound is produced and heard. We will explore vibrations by investigating the relationship between how an object vibrates and the sound it makes.

Computing

We will learn how to program a sprite to change costume and move using the program Scratch.

E-safety

Children will revise what is personal information and what should not be shared online.

Religious Education

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of Creation.

Physical Education

PE for Class 3 will be on Mondays and Fridays. Aspire will be leading the sessions on Mondays and swimming will take place for year 4 on Friday afternoon whilst year 3 take part in ball skills at school. Please ensure your child comes in, in their PE kit on PE days.

Music

In music Class 3 will be learning how to pluck and strum a guitar and learn how to improvise.

RHE – Relationship Health Education

This half term we will be learning about what it is to be a good friend and how we can cope with different social situations.

French

In French we will be learning the vowel sounds and basic French phrases.

Art

Children will be creating their own silhouette of the Blitz using paints to colour mix. During our Art Days this half term, we will create our own clay sculptures based on the artist Henry Moore

History

Our topic is based around the history of World War Two. We will learn how long WW2 lasted and why it began, as well as about the life of an evacuee and the important roles that people had to obtain.
