What are we going to be learning?

The hook for a lot of our learning this half term is 'Nurturing Nurses'. We will start this with our history learning about Florence Nightingale. We will use this in our literacy when we write a short recount about Florence Nightingale. We will also do some writing based on 'Funny Bones' by Janet and Allan Ahlberg and some instructional writing based on making snowflakes. In maths we will be learning about common 2D shapes, partitioning using the bar model and composition of numbers 6 to 10. Our science learning will be about humans, a mammal and their senses. They will also continue to observe the weather and changes over the seasons. In PE with Active8 on a Tuesday the children will develop their body control focussing on hopping, skipping and leaping and jumping. Thursday's PE with Mrs Ingham Thomas will be gymnastics. Our Concept for RE will be 'Symbol of Light' in the context of the symbol of light in Diwali. During our computer lessons we will be learning about the word 'technology' and when we use it in our classroom. We will start to learn how to use a computer e.g controlling the mouse. In music the children will build on their knowledge of a steady beat and rhythm and begin to develop their singing and performing skills. In art we will be developing our drawing skills with a focus on spirals and learning about the artist Molly Haslund.
