Literacy

Our literacy learning will be based on Oliver Twist by Charles Dickens, we will have a range of writing opportunities including descriptions, persuasive writing and reports. We will be recapping more challenging aspects of punctuation and grammar to use in our writing

Maths

Year 5s will be continuing to look at adding and subtracting fractions, we will be moving on to understanding how to find a common denominator when the denominators are not multiples. Year 6s will be looking at scaling, proportion and ratio. We will then move back together and the whole class will look at percentages and decimals and will use them in a range of calculations.

Science

In Science, we will be continuing to look at reversible and irreversible changes. We will then begin to look at the properties of different household materials.

Computing and E-Safety

In E-Safety, we will be looking at spam. In computing, we will be learning about data handling.

Religious Education

This half term our concept is Love as Salvation. We will be explaining our own responses and experience of love as salvation or being saved

Geography

Our Geography learning this half term will be looking at the human and physical features of the UK, then focusing on Portsmouth to learn about different land uses and how they differ to Petersfield.

Physical Education

PE for Class 4 will be on Mondays and Thursdays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays. On Thursdays we will be learning a dance to the song Footloose.

RHE
