

'Our Changing World'

Literacy

Our literacy learning will be based on Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo. We will have a range of writing opportunities throughout the learning journey. We will be creating a survival guide, a diary and a character description.

Maths

In Maths we will be looking to use our knowledge in problem solving. We will look at angles, triangles, area and perimeter, volume and basic algebra. We will then recap factors, multiples, prime and squared numbers.

Science

In Science, we will be continuing to learn about the properties of materials and reversible and irreversible changes. We will then move on to look at classification and evolution.

Computing and E-Safety

In E-Safety, we will be looking at the importance of online safety using emails, passwords and the dangers of spam. In Computing, we will be using physical computing to explore the concept of selection in programming through the use of the Crumble programming environment.

Religious Education

Our concept will be God Talk. We will be looking at the concept of Christian views of God. We will then learn about what it means if God is holy and loving.

Geography

In Geography this half term our big question will be "Is every country equal?" We will be looking at the distribution of resources around the world.

Physical Education

PE for Class 4 will be on Mondays and Thursdays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays, they will be studying tennis. On Thursdays the class will be learning a country style dance.

RHE

Our discussion focus for this half term will be about relationships, we will be looking different types of relationships and how they change as we grow. We will be looking into the transition between primary and secondary school.

French

We will be studying the alphabet and looking at French phonics, we will then begin to talk about ourselves.

Art

We be looking at creating 3D buildings. We will be looking at how artists and designers have responsibilities. We will be looking at some architects and how they design buildings, then we will create our own.

Music

Our music lessons will focus on learning about the history of music beginning at the medieval and looking how music evolved into contemporary music.
