Literacy

The children will be writing a descriptive narrative from a stimulus using expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and powerful verbs and adjectives. They will also be writing a setting description around the book 'The Tin Forest' by Helen Ward and Wayne Anderson.

Maths

We will be learning units of time and how to tell the time to nearest minute and formal written multiplication methods multiplying two digit and one digit numbers.

Science

Our Science focus this half term is mixtures and substances. We will identify what a substance and mixture are and how to separate substances in a variety of ways.

Computing and E-safety

In computing we will be learning about desktop publishing and how to insert text and images. In e-safety we are learning how to network safely using the web.

Religious Education

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of 'Special as God' in the context of God.

Geography

We will be using atlases, globes and maps to locate the town of Sorrento in the country of Italy. We will identify the physical and human features and compare them to our local area.

Physical Education

This half-term, PE for Class 3 will be on Mondays and Tuesdays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays teaching tennis, while Tuesdays lessons will be gymnastics.
