## Literacy

Literacy learning this term will be based around the text 'The Mousehole Cat'. Class 3 will be writing the story from another perspective by putting themselves into the shoes of another character. In the second unit we will be writing tourist leaflets to persuade the public to visit Petersfield.

## Maths

We will be learning how to identify different types of angles and learning the short division method through partitioning.

## Science

Our Science focus this half term is digestion and plant reproduction. We will be learning to understand the role of digestion and how plants reproduce through the process of pollination.

## Computing and E-safety

In computing we will continue to learn how to use desktop publishing and create different algorithms in the programme Scratch. E-safety will focus on how to use email safely.

## Religious Education

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of 'Transformation' in the context of a Christian story.

## Geography

This term our topic will be all about Petersfield, where we will use a range of atlases and maps to locate it, identify its features and observe how the town has changed over time.

## Physical Education

This half-term, PE for Class 3 will be on Mondays and Tuesdays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays teaching cricket, while Tuesdays lessons will be dance.

## RHE - Relationships and Health Education

Our focus for this half term is how to keep safe when out and how to manage risks.

## French

To revise the phonics sounds learnt so far and continue to learn the different seasons. We will also describe our characteristics using French phrases.
Art
Class 3 will be creating their own sculptures finding inspiration from literature, film, dance or music.

## Music

In music, Class 3 will continue learning how to play the ukulele following simple music.
