## Literacy

We will be focusing our lessons around the book The Firework-Maker's Daughter. We will write for a range of purposes, including character descriptions and diary entries.

#### Maths

Our first focus will be to deepen our understanding of the place value of larger numbers. We will also revise calculation strategies.

#### Science

In Science we will be working on learning about controlling electrical circuits.

### Computing and E-safety

In computing, Class 4 will be learning about how computer systems and networks work including the internet, using technical vocabulary.

### **Religious Education**

Our first Concept day will be 'Conflicting or Complimentary' in the context of creation and science.

#### History

Our History learning this half term will focus on where and when some of the earliest civilisations appeared around the world. We will also study some of their achievements.

# **Physical Education**

PE for Class 4 this half term will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays. On Wednesdays Year 5 will go swimming and Year 6 will work towards designing their own fitness circuit in groups.

#### RHE - Relationships and Health Education

We will be considering what makes up a person's identity, focusing on personal attributes and qualities, similarities and differences, individuality and stereotypes.

#### **French**

We will be learning how to tell the time in French, recapping the numbers to 80, months of the year and how to ask questions and give responses.

#### DT

Our focus objective is to learn how to support structures through the building of bridges.

#### Music

Music this half term will be taught by a music specialist from Hampshire Music Service. The focus will be on duration, dynamics and tempo taught through 'In The Hall Of The Mountain King'.
