What are we going to be learning?

Welcome to Froxfield Primary School and Class I. Starting school is an exciting occasion for all the Wrens. We will all be learning and establishing school and class routines right from the start of term. In phonics the children will be building up their knowledge of sounds and learning to blend these to read simple words. They will be reading daily in school and bringing these books home to share. Initially books with no pictures to build their own oral language and then with simple words that directly link to the sounds they have learnt in class. In maths the children will become familiar with subitising numbers I to 4 including combining different sets to make these numbers. They will also begin to understand the purpose of counting and practise counting with 1:1 correspondence. In science we will observe and describe the weather associated with Autumn and begin to observe changes across the four seasons. In PE with Active 8 on a Tuesday the children will develop their running and agility. Thursday's PE with Mrs. Ingham Thomas will be dance based on the 'Great Fire of London'. Our Concept for RE will be 'Thanking' in the context of Harvest Festival. Design Technology will enable them to develop their cutting skills. We are also looking forward to sharing the Wrens' chatterboxes within the class. In music the children will use the nursery rhyme 'London's Burning' to begin to understand dynamics, how to play percussion instruments and rehearse for performing.
