Literacy

Literacy learning this term will be based around the text 'The Enormous Crocodile', by Roald Dahl. Class 3 will be writing an additional chapter in the style of the author and creating their own Brazilian animal to create a non-chronological report.

Maths

We will continue to add and subtract numbers using the column method and apply this to a range of problems. We will also focus on learning multiplication and division facts and applying them to problems.

Science

Our Science focus this half term is animals, skeletons and movement. We will learn the functions of the skeleton and identify animals that are invertebrates and vertebrates.

Computing and E-safety

In computing we will be learning about audio production.

Religious Education

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of 'Holy' in the context of 'Mother of God'.

Geography

Our topic this half term is about Brazil, with a focus on Rio de Janeiro. We will be using our mapping skills to find out where it is in the world in comparison to us, and finding out about the culture, life and landmarks it holds.
