Anchors Away Wrens Cluster Sheet

What are we going to be learning?

The hook for a lot of our learning this half term is 'Anchors Away'. We will use this in our literacy when we become familiar with the story 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' by John Burningham. The children will write a thank you card to Mr Gumpy. The children will continue to develop speed and accuracy in reading phoneme grapheme correspondents including digraphs and trigraphs. This will enable them to become more confident and fluent readers and they will continue to apply this phonic knowledge to early writing. In Maths the children will begin to develop their understanding of the composition of numbers. Knowing that numbers are made up of two or more smaller numbers and be able to compare the numerosity of these sets. The children will continue to be encouraged to develop their interest and curiosity about the world around them including continuing to understanding the effect of the changing seasons and notice and observe plants. The children will also develop their understanding of past and present observing differences such as clothing in 1912 compared to now. PE with Active8 will focus on moving with an object, dribbling a ball and bouncing a ball and the children will be learning how to May dance using a Maypole with me on a Thursday. Our RE learning will be about the Concept of Power (A) in the context of the Hindu God Ganesh. In music the children will develop their composing and performing skills whilst thinking about duration, dynamics and tempo. In Computing, the children will start to recognise the letters on the keyboard to spell their name. For their DT learning, the children will use junk modelling to make a simple model of the Titanic.
