



**What are we going to be learning in Class Two?**

Our new topic will continue for the whole of the summer term and we're really looking forward to lots of exciting opportunities to get outside.

In Literacy this half term we will be reading 'The Tale of Mr. Jeremy Fisher' by Beatrix Potter, we will then be creating our very own piece of writing called 'An interview with Mr. Jeremy Fisher'. In Maths, the children will continue to focus on the 2, 5 and 10 times table, alongside looking at doubling, halving and division. With Mrs Bibby in Maths we will return to looking at shape and time. Children will continue to work on their tennis skills in PE, and we will begin to learn our dance for May Dancing! PE will continue to be on a Tuesday and Thursday this half term. Our science learning will focus on health and exercise, looking at the basic needs of animals, including humans, to survive alongside exercise, food and hygiene. In geography, we will be taking a walk around Froxfield to learn about the human and physical features of our local area. We will be linking our topic to DT and making a frog hand puppet.
