

# 'Mayan Magic'

## Literacy

This half term we will be working on our individual report comments and then composing, redrafting and performing speeches using the skills we learnt earlier in the year.

## Maths

In maths we will continue to focus on arithmetic skills and continue our learning on fraction, decimal and percentage equivalents.

## Science

In Science, we will be learning about sound: How is it produced and how the pitch and volume is changed.

## Computing and E-safety

In computing, we will be exploring the content of children's and familiar websites, using technical vocabulary to compare and evaluate these websites. Our e-safety lessons will be sharing 'SMART' rules to follow to stay safe online including privacy and online profiles.

## Religious Education

This half term our concept is Belonging. We will be looking at our own ideas about belonging and then relate this to traditions followed by Muslims.

## History

Our history learning this half term will focus on the Mayans, we will be looking into different aspects of Mayan daily life. We will be using our knowledge of other ancient civilisations to begin to understand why there are some misinterpretations about the Mayans.

## Physical Education

PE for Class 4 will be on Mondays and Tuesdays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays, on Tuesdays we will focus on athletics skills.

## RHE

This half term we will be learning about how our bodies and feelings change as we grow up and for year 6 only 'How babies are made'.

## French

We will be continuing our learning on clothes and how to describe what we are wearing in French.

## DT

We will explore and research food ingredients for a recipe following a criteria, evaluating our finished recipe afterwards.

## Music

Our music lessons will be looking into composition of music using a range of skills developed throughout the year.
