Literacy

Literacy learning this term will be based around the book 'How to Train your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell, where the children will be writing character descriptions and a set of instructions. Throughout the unit we will discuss the use of speech and how to punctuate it correctly.

Maths

We will be learning how to do short division using the method of partitioning and we will continue to learn multiplication and apply it in a range of ways.

Science

Our Science focus this half term will be states of matter. We will learn about the properties of solids, liquids and gases as well as how materials may change state.

Computing and E-safety

In computing, we will be learning to do simple coding using the software scratch. Our E-safety focus will be 'copycats' in the context of online plagiarism.

Religious Education

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of 'Obedience' in the context of 'Obeying God's rules'.

History

Our topic this half term is all about the Vikings. We will be learning why the Vikings came to Britain and how they made an impact questioning whether they came to Britain to raid or to trade?

Physical Education

This half-term, PE for Class 3 will continue to be on **Mondays and Tuesdays**. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays, while Tuesdays lessons will be athletics outside.
