What are we going to be learning in Class Two?

This half term we will continue to work on our topic 'Froxfield Fun!' with a new focus on history. In literacy we will be working on a page to be included in our summer reports and writing a narrative inspired by the book 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne. In maths, Class Two will continue to work on multiplication, division, time, shape and fractions. In science we will be learning about pushes and pulls. There will be a local theme to our history - learning about the history of our school with a focus on Victorian classrooms which the children always find extremely interesting and a little surprising! This term's art is 'Be an Architect', we will look at the architecture of Hundertwasser and Zaha Hadid and make our own architectural models. Our concept for RE will be Love as Friendship in the context of the Gospel. In computing the children will learn simple coding using Scratch Junior software. P.E will continue to be on a Tuesday and Thursday this half term and the children will focus on running, balancing, ball and co-ordination skills to prepare for sports day.

How can learning be extended at home?

Please continue to support your child at home with daily reading, homework, spellings, Doodle Maths and maths challenge cards. Spelling test day will continue to be on a Thursday and new spellings will be taken home the following day. In this final half term, the children will be practising their tables daily at school so any focus on these at home would be hugely beneficial.
