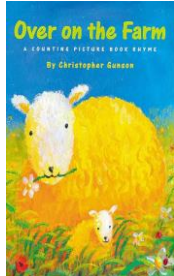

Focus Text: Over on the Farm by Christopher Gunson

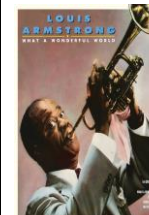
