



## **Class Four 'Democracy Rules'**

**3rd September to 25th October**

### **Literacy**

Our Literacy learning will be based on Greek Myths. We will be reading a variety of myths then writing our own quest myths.. Later in the half term, the children will work on some non-fiction writing related to Greek Myths.

### **Maths**

Our first focus will be to deepen our understanding of the place value of larger numbers. We will also revise calculation strategies and focus on consolidating our times table and division facts knowledge.

### **Science**

In science, we will be learning about forces that oppose motion with a continued focus on how and why things move. Class Four will work on planning their own scientific investigations to answer questions.

### **Computing and E-safety**

In computing, we will be talking about e-safety and what to do when spam, pop-up or other unwanted messages appear online. We will be also be learning about how data is organised in a flat-file database.

### **Religious Education**

This half term our concept is 'Ritual', we will be looking into the significance of ritual during Wudu and Eid-ul Fitr.

### **History**

Our history learning this half term will focus on the Ancient Greeks and their legacy.

### **Physical Education**

PE for Class 4 will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays and will be taking part in Tag Rugby and invasion games. On Wednesdays Year 5 will go swimming and Year 6 will work towards designing their own fitness circuit in groups.

### **RHE**

Our focal points for this half term will be about health, wellbeing and relationships. We be looking into mental and physical health and how we are able to improve our overall health.

### **French**

We are beginning this term by recapping on simple introductions, then we will move on to discussing, 'Ma Famille'.

### **DT**

We will be exploring and researching how to create slippers. We will then design and create our own slippers with a focus on sewing skills.

### **Music**

The children will learn about dynamics, tempo and structure this half term with Hampshire Music Service.
