What are we going to be learning in Class Two?

In literacy, we will be reading 'Lila and the Secret of Rain' and writing our own setting descriptions. We will also be writing postcards in response to 'Meerkat Mail'. In maths we will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction. Our science learning this half term will centre on 'Animals Including Humans'. Our geography learning will closely link to our topic, the children will learn to identify continents and oceans on a map of the world, discover where hot and cold regions are located and learn about geographical features. Art will focus on drawing in different ways with a variety of tools and mediums. P.E will be on a Tuesday and Thursday. On Tuesday, the children will be working on ball control in relation to football, and Thursday we will be creating our own version of the 'Haka' dance. Our concept for RE will be 'Belonging' in the context of family and faith.

How can learning be extended at home?

Please support your child at home with daily reading, homework, spellings and maths challenge cards. Spelling test day will be on a Thursday and five new spellings will be taken home the following day. Homework will be set on a Friday and should be handed in by the following Wednesday please.
