

'The Conquerors' Legacy'

Literacy

The children will carry out a unit of work linked to 'Romans on the Rampage!' by Jeremy Strong. They will read and analyse the text and have a focus on paragraphs. At the end of the units children will write a non-chronological report about Chariot Racing.

Maths

We will be identifying, representing and comparing unit fractions, finding fractions of amounts and adding and subtracting them within and over a whole.

Science

Our Science focus this half term is materials. We will be exploring different mixtures and how to separate them through dissolving, filtering and evaporating.

Computing and E-safety

In computing we will be learning how to use branching databases and in e-safety we are learning about being positive and kind online.

Religious Education

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of 'Suffering' in the context of the 'Easter Story'.

History

We will continue to learn about why the Romans decided to invade Britain and the impact they had. We will also begin to understand aspects of the long term impact of the Roman Empire and their significance.

Physical Education

This half-term, PE for Class 3 will be on **Mondays and Tuesdays**. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays on tennis skills, while Tuesdays lessons we will be doing gymnastics.

RHE – Relationships and Health Education

Our focus for this half term will be health and wellbeing learning about how we grow and change.

French

We will learning how to say different classroom objects and respond to simple classroom commands.

DT

Class 3 will be applying their electrical circuits' knowledge and skills from their Science learning to create a simple game.

Music

In music, Class 3 will be continuing to learn how to play African drums.
