## **Literacy**

The children will be writing a descriptive narrative from a stimulus using expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and powerful verbs and adjectives. They will also be writing a setting description around the book 'The Tin Forest' by Helen Ward and Wayne Anderson.

## **Maths**

We will be learning to use the partition method leading to the short multiplication method to multiply 2 and 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit number. We will also identify different angles and recognise whether they are greater or less than a right angle.

## **Science**

Our Science focus this half term is animals, teeth and digestion. We will identify that animals and humans, need the right amount of nutrition from what they eat and that humans require a balanced diet to remain healthy.

## **Computing and E-safety**

In computing we will be learning about desktop publishing and how to insert text and images. In e-safety we are learning how to network safely using the web.

## **Religious Education**

Our concept days this half term will be linked to the key concept of 'Special as God' in the context of God.

## **Geography**

We will be using atlases, globes and maps to locate the town of Sorrento in the country of Italy. We will identify the physical and human features and compare them to our local area.

## **Physical Education**

This half-term, PE for Class 3 will be on **Mondays and Tuesdays**. Aspire Coaching will work with the class on Mondays teaching tennis, while Tuesdays lessons will be dance.

## **RHE – Relationships and Health Education**

Our focus for this half term is how our choices can make a difference to others and the environment.

## **French**

We will be learning four new phonic sounds. We will continue to learn how to say different classroom objects and respond to simple classroom commands.
