

Let's Play Wrens Cluster Sheet



2nd June to 22nd July 2025

What are we going to be learning?

The hook for a lot of our learning this half term is 'Let's Play' a history led topic. In our literacy we will be reading 'Toys in Space' by Mini Grey where the children will make a 'Lost Poster' with words to describe the missing teddy. They will also look at some non-fiction texts about toys and write sentences/words for an information text. In maths the Wrens will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies. They will secure knowledge of number facts through varied practice and practise subitising and comparing quantities. Our science learning will be about the human body. We will also continue to monitor the weather to understand the seasons. In history we will be looking at toys from the past. This will focus on toys in living memory and then further into the past. PE with Active8 will focus on invasion games such as tag and the children will be developing their agility, balance and co-ordination with me on a Thursday. Our concept for RE will be 'Change' in the context of 'People Jesus met'. In Computing, children will begin to learn how to programme a simple command on a bee-bot. In music the children will focus on dynamics and tempo as well as rehearsing and performing. In Art, the children will explore print-making using found objects. In addition all Wrens will take part in five forest school sessions on a Wednesday morning: 4th June, 11th June, 2nd July, 9th July, 16th July. On these days they should come to school in non-uniform and they must have long sleeves and long trousers to protect their arms and legs.

What will the hook be?

Using the history resources from Hampshire history box and visit from Mrs Hollis and Mr Sadler.

How will we celebrate learning outcomes?

Parents and carers will be invited to Class 1's toy museum on Monday 9th June.
Sports Day on Wednesday 18th June.

Key Vocabulary:

History: old, new, past, present, artefacts
Science: body, inside, outside, senses

How can learning be extended at home? (Your child will also bring home homework tasks, their current mental maths card and please see the reading record) Please support your child with continuing their routines such as arriving at school on time as well as remembering their book bag, water bottle and coat every day. They will need to come to school on a Tuesday and Thursday in PE kit plus school shoes as they need to leave their trainers in school to be used every day. They will need to have **plimsolls** in their school PE bag at school. Please make sure long hair is always tied back. Continue with reading routines at home developing fluidity always recording in their diary. Homework will be sent out on a Friday for Wrens to complete by the following Thursday. Please continue to work with your child on their mental maths card.
